In addition, considered to know the problems faced by the students and the consequent from the academic performance of one of key topics and linking the university quality and academic accreditation "The annual report National Survey revealed Of Student Engagement many of the problems faced by students during the study. Through several, direct questions for students to answer, Such as what are benefiting from your studies? What is your assessment of the quality of interactive relationship between you and the faculty members? ... And so on

Research Goals:

- 1. Identify problems faced by students during the Academic advisory from their point of view.
- 2. Monitoring of these problems of the educational reality of the credit hour system.
- 3. Identify the differences between the problems of female students and students.
- 4. Identify the differences problems of altered age students.
- 5. Identify the differences problems for different types of specialization.

- 6. Identify the problems of altered differences between institute and university.
- 7. Enable students from the academic and psychological adjustment to the credit hour system by solving problems that face them.

Research Results:

Find revealed many of the problems faced by students during the process of doing Academic advisory include the following:

First, the relevant results of the students:

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- More than half of respondents (51.9%) do not know what is meant by academic advisory.
- That (48.9%) of the total respondents do not have the opportunity to choose disciplines to suit their interests and abilities.
- And(47.7%) who feel a sense of concern with regard to the adoption certificate from the ministry.

Second, the results of the relevant academic Advisor:

- That (51.1%) of the total respondents suffering from problems due to the change of study academic advisor.
- That (49.8%) of the total respondents was concerned because
 of the lack of help his academic advisor.
- That (48.9%) of the total respondents do not care about the importance of taking her mind when you ask subjects before the school year.

Third, the results of the relevant academic Advisor:

 That (51.5%) of the total respondents believe that the university administration or the institute you subtract subjects is not a student the right to choose what suits them.

- That (44.7) of the total respondents believes that the management of the Institute does not adequately subtracting the number and variety of courses Decisions.
- That (44.7) of the total respondents believe that the limited number of articles put forward in the beginning of the semester for the student cause to wait for the next semester or next year, delaying the completion of student teaching career at the specified time.
