INFORMATION LITERACY AND ITS RELATIONSHIP TO PSYCHOLOGICAL EMPOWERMENT AMONG GRADUATE STUDENTS FACULTY OF EDUCATION, KING KHALID UNIVERSITY, SAUDI ARABIA



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Abstract:

The present study aimed at identifying the degree of practicing information awareness and the level of psychological empowerment among graduate students at the College of Education, Abha, King Khalid University in Saudi Arabia. Program, level of study). The research sample consisted of (85) male and female students of the Master's and Ph.D. programs at the Faculty of Education. The descriptive method was used. The researcher designed and constructed the two measures of information awareness and psychological empowerment to apply to the current research sample.
