DIFFERENCES IN SPIRITUAL INTELLIGENCE AND QUALITY OF LIFE FOR DEAF ADOLESCENTS OF BOTH SEXES, AL-AMAL SCHOOLS FOR THE DEAF AND DUMB IN SUEZ

Abstract:

The present study aimed to uncover differences in spiritual intelligence and quality of life among deaf adolescents. On a sample size of (40) male and female students with an average age of (14-18) and a standard deviation of (6.818). To achieve this goal, the quality of life scale (prepared by the current researchers) and the spiritual intelligence scale (Prepared: Arnout, 2016) were used. The results showed that there were statistically significant differences in spiritual intelligence (total score - dimensions) and quality of life (total score -
